perfect the title; Therefore I now by these presents
that the said J. C. Gower, in consideration of the sum
and of the sum of One dollar to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by Charles
T. Hammond of the County of Greenville, in the state
aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have granted, bargained, sold and released, and
by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto the said Charles T. Hammond all that cer-
tain piece, parcel and lot of land, situated lying
and being in the County and State aforesaid near
the City of Greenville, and having the following
lines, Miles and bounds to wit; Beginning at a stone
34, (Formerly red Oak down), and running thence E 6 1/4 E,
16.00 to a stone 34, thence S 59 1/4 W 14.35 to a stone 34;
thence S. 7 W 15.40 to the beginning. Together with all
and singular the Rights, Miners, Hereditaments
and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging
or in anywise incident or appertaining to same
and to have all and singular the said premises
before mentioned unto the said Charles T. Hammond
his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind my
self, my heirs, Executors and Administrators to wear
and forever defend all and singular the said
premises unto the said Charles T. Hammond his
heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs & all
other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same
or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal
this 1st day of December in the One hundred and
fifteenth year of the Sovereignty and Independence
of the United States of America.
