I, Rebecca Marchbanks, and my heirs, know ye, that the said Rebecca Marchbanks the party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars to her in hand paid by G. W. Service, the party of second part, at and before the reading & closing of these presents, the receipt whereof is here by acknowledged, hath granted, conveyed, released, and forever quit-claimed, and by these presents doth grant, release, remit and forever quit-claim unto the said G. W. Service, his heirs and assigns forever all the dower and thirds, right and title of dower and thirds, and all other rights, title, interest, property, claims and demand whatsoever in law and equity of her, the said party of the first part, of in and to all that certain piece parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in said County & state being a part of the tract purchased by S. W. Marchbanks, J. M. Marchbank and Mary E. Langthorn from William Symmes; formerly owned by Stephen Marchbanks; containing One hundred, fifteen and 5/100 Acres, more or less, and having the following metes, bounds to wit; beginning at a stone on road from the line Mt. to Hampden Mt. and running thence N 28 E 970 to a Chestnut Oak; thence N 47 1/4 E 41, 25 to a pine; thence N 42 1/4 E 1800 to a stone; thence N 47 1/4 E 53, 90 to a stone; thence S 12 1/2 E 1200 to a stone; thence N 36 1/2 E 1700 to the beginning the same lying that parcel of Land owned by her self, Marchbank, Jefferson Marchbank, and Parley E. Langthorn to S. W. Service on Oct 5 1885. With the said parcel of
