Have granted, bargained, sold, released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell release and transfer unto the American Pipe Company, its successors and assigns forever the right of way over the following tract of land in the County and State aforesaid containing about three four and one half acres more or less, known as the Estate Lands of Mrs E. W. Craft and by lands of Mrs M. Craft, Nancy Goodlett, Louis Cole and others, for the purpose of laying a pipe aqueduct or other suitable means of conveying water from Paris Mountain to the City of Greenville, with the right to the said American Pipe Company, its successors, Agents Servants and assigns forever, to pass over said tract of land whenever said grantee may desire to do so, and perform such work, repairs, excavations, filling, leveling and wagoning as may be necessary for the purpose of laying the pipes, aqueducts or other means of conveying said water as aforesaid, and for maintaining and repairing the same; and the said American Pipe Company, its successors and assigns shall have the right to select and locate where the right of way shall pass, of any said tract of land, any crop which may be injured to be paid for. The rights of the grantee shall be limited to the privileges unto the American Pipe Company, its successors and assigns forever. And I do here by these my self, my heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend the said the said right of way and privileges above granted unto the American Pipe Company, its successors, and assigns, against myself, my heirs and all other persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or interfere them with. Provided nevertheless that the same shall be and remain forever subject of the land, and in no way to interfere with the privileges & duties.

S. Green, L. V. Green and others, for the purpose of laying a pipe, aqueduct or other suitable means of conveying water from Paris Mountain to the City of Greenville, with the right to the said American Pipe Company, its successors, Agents, servants and assigns forever to pass over said tract of land whenever said grantee may desire to do so, and to perform such work, repairs, excavations, filling, leveling and wagoning as may be necessary for the purpose of laying the pipes, aqueducts or other means of conveying said water as aforesaid, and for maintaining and repairing the same; and the said American Pipe Company, its successors and assigns shall have the right to select and locate where said right of way, at all times over said tract of land; any crop which may be injured to be paid for.
