M. Paris all that parcel or tract of land in the County & State aforesaid on waters of South Tyger river in Oreal Township having the following metes & boundaries. Beginning at a stone on the Mays Bridge Road on the Miss Wat's line running south 31 $\frac{1}{4}$ deg 44'.85 to a stone on R. L. Andrews land Thence with the creek a crooked line to a stone Thence N 37 $\frac{1}{4}$ deg E 24'.60 to a stone. Thence N 50' E 11' to a stone. Thence N 39 $\frac{1}{4}$ deg E 24'.60 to a stone on the Mays Bridge Road. Thence up said road to the beginning corner, reference to a plat made by J. G.
