in the State aforesaid, stand in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these Presents, by Elizabeth Garrant of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said Elizabeth Garrant all that certain piece of land or lot of land situated lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, beginning thirty three (33) acres more or less, two and one half miles North of Greenville, the Court House on River of Richland Creek branch waters of Reedy River and bounded by lands of three tracts and lands formerly belonging to Abraham Green now deceased, Beginning on a Red Oak stump 33 rods running thence N 84° 22.80 to a stone 39 on thence S 71° E 1.90 to a stone 39 on main line, thence N 34° 18' E 35.40 to the beginning, plus a certain other piece of land bounded by stone 39 on the main line and a road, beginning at stone 39 on the main line, thence N 34° 18' E 35.40 to a stake, thence S 64° 46' E 275.9 to a stone 39 at the end of the new Road, thence with said road S 64° 46' E to the beginning again, containing twenty and one fourth acres, more or less and designated by a post of the same and E 35.40 to the beginning corner being the same three hundred feet of land conveyed to me by B. G. G.
