all that that part or parcel of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville and in the Corporate limits of the City of Greenville and State aforesaid, on the East side of Greenville Court House and on the East side of Boyce St. Beginning at a stake + one Boyce St and street w. ft wide, thence N 14° 48' 53 1/4 ft to stake + Newmans corner thence S 70° E 120 ft to a stake + thence S 13° W 84 1/4 ft to a stake + on said w. st. thence N 70° E 20 1/2 ft to the beginning corner. Containing 16,500 square ft or about one fourth of an acre by the same more or less, and bounded by Mrs Newman's said Washington Street and said two streets.
