I. A. J. Jordan agrees to rent to Willis Seaborn for a term of five years a certain boundary of land which has been agreed on and staked off by the parties supposed to be twelve acres about eleven acres in woods.

II. Willis Seaborn party of the second part agrees to take the land agreed on by he and A. J. Jordan to clear it up, to give said Jordan one half of the wood, to ditch the land well and take good care of the land, so that it will not wash and to pay as rent the sum of Ninety Dollars, one half due Decr 15th 1893 and the other half due Decr 15th 1894.
