Whereas The Paris Mountain Water Company a corporation created and organized under the laws of the State of South Carolina is engaged under franchises granted by the City Council of Greenville in said State in furnishing the said City of Greenville and its inhabitants, and others along the line of its mains with water for protection against fire and fire ~~domestic~~ domestic, sanitary, and other useful purposes, and whereas the source of said water supply is certain affluents of Mountains which said creek flows through the lands of Joseph Edwards, and any diversion of the affluents aforesaid is a violation of his riparian rights and whereas the said water Company through its duly authorized officers and agents, and the said Joseph Edwards have mutually agreed upon the sum and price to be paid by said water Company to said Joseph Edwards for the right and privilege of diverting the water of the aforesaid affluents, Now therefore know all men by these presents that I the said Joseph Edwards in consideration of the premises, and of the sum of Six Hundred Dollars being the sum agreed upon as aforesaid to be paid by the said The Paris Mountain Water Company here by itself, my heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns granted, bargained, sold, released and transferred, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release and transfer unto the said The Paris Mountain Water Company, its Successors and assigns forever the right and privilege of taking the water from said stream, affluents of said Mountain Creek as aforesaid, for the use and purposes aforesaid
