Mansfield & Co., but are to bear all expenses of putting same in condition for marketing such as bottling, labeling, printing, advertising etc, etc, and that the said party of the first part has no interest whatsoever in the transaction or mode of sale, other than the royalty before mentioned, and that the management of the sale of the said Tonic is entirely in the hands of the party of the second part. The party of the second part agree to use their best efforts to place the said article before the public and increase its sale, and use all reasonable business methods to bring about an increased demand for the goods.

It is also understood that should the party of the second part so desire at the expiration of this agreement, they are to have the privilege of extending same for a term of years or less on a similar basis as set forth in this agreement.

And also that should the expiration of this agreement terminate the sale of said Tonic by the party of the second part, then the party of the first part hereby agree to purchase from said party of the second part or any and all Tonic, Stock of bottles or Supplies whatsoever used in preparing same for market, that the said party of the second part may at that time have on hand.
