Marney, L. Ratschied, S.M. Snider, John S. Green, Thum Earl (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said H.C. Marney, L. Ratschied, S.M. Snider, John S. Green and Thum Earl an undivided seven-eighths ($\frac{7}{8}$) interest in and to all that piece, parcel, tract of land situate in the County and State aforesaid, or thereabout, being about four and one half miles from Greenville Court House, containing about three hundred and thirty four acres, more or less, being the same land conveyed to the said Hannie W. Hunter by John W. Stokes by deed bearing date the 11th day of April 1877, said lands being fully described as to metes & bounds in said deed, & in the complaint in aforesaid case, as more appear by reference to the record thereof, Judgment Roll A. 1166.

The respective interests of the above parties being as follows:

Each having his share of the purchase money in that proportion; H.C. Marney an undivided one-fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) interest; L. Ratschied an undivided one-fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) interest; S.M. Snider an undivided one-eighth ($\frac{1}{8}$) interest; John S. Green an undivided one-eighth ($\frac{1}{8}$) interest; Thum Earl an undivided one eighth ($\frac{1}{8}$) interest; and the remaining one-eighth ($\frac{1}{8}$) interest I still retain.

Together with all and singular the Rights, members, Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

Do here and by hand, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said H.C. Marney, L. Ratschied, S.M. Snider, John S. Green, and Thum Earl, their heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said H.C. Marney, L. Ratschied, S.M. Snider, John S. Green and Thum Earl, their heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs.
