Know all men by these Presents:
That I, Alexander M. Bee, being the owner of the
fee unincumbered, by any mortgage, judgment or other
lien of a certain tract of land, lying and being in
the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina,
containing one acre, lying on the waters of Brushy
Creek and bounded as follows: Beginning on a
rock near the S.W. Corner of the Still house, running
thence due East seventy yards to a rock; thence
due West seventy yards to a rock; thence due South
seventy yards to the beginning corner, and bounded
on all sides by lands of Alexander M. Bee do hereby
Consent that the said may be used by James E.
Payne for the purpose of distilling spirits subject to
the provisions of the law. This Consent to exist for
the period of two years, and I do hereby stipulate
and agree that the laws of the United States for Duties
and Penalties shall have priority of all my right,
title and interest in said tract of land or any
claim in my behalf, and that in case of forfeiture of
of said premises or any part thereof, the title to the
same shall rest in the United States, discharged from
all my right, title and interest, or any claim in my behalf.
