

The State of South Carolina.

Whereas, The Paris Mountain Water Company, a Corporation duly created and organized under the laws of the State of South Carolina, is engaged under powers granted by its Charter and under franchise conferred by the City Council of Greenville, South Carolina, in furnishing said City of Greenville and its inhabitants and others along the lines of its main with water for protection against fire, and for domestic, sanitary and other useful purposes; and whereas, the source of water supply for said purposes, present and prospective, is certain affluents of Enoree River, which said River flows through and by the lands of Alfred Taylor, of Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, and any diversion of the affluents of said River about his said lands is a violation of his riparian rights. And, whereas, the said water Company, by its duly authorized officers and agents, and the said Alfred Taylor have mutually agreed upon the sum and price to be paid by the said Water Company to the said Alfred Taylor for the right and privilege of diverting the water of said affluents for the purposes aforesaid. Now, therefore, know all men by these presents, That I, the said Alfred Taylor, in consideration of the premises and of the sum of four hundred dollars to me paid by the said The Paris Mountain Water Company, being the sum and price agreed upon as aforesaid, and for myself, my heirs, Executors, Administrators, and assigns, granted, bargained, sold, released, assigned, transferred and set over, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release, assign, transfer and set over unto the said The Paris Mountain Water Company its successors, and assigns, forever the right and privilege of diverting and taking the waters from the affluents of said Enoree River for the uses and purposes aforesaid, and the said sum of four hundred dollars is hereby received and accepted as full satisfaction for all damage, injury and inconvenience which have arisen, or may hereafter arise to me, my heirs, Executors, Administrators or assigns, by reason of the diversion of said waters for the purposes aforesaid.)
