Know all men by these presents that the City Council of Greenville in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty five Dollars to be in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by the said City Council, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said W. L. Trail, of No 130, of Spring road Cemetery, having the following dimensions to wit, Fourteen feet wide by twenty one feet long for the use of burial and sundry purposes and to be used exclusively for the use and purpose aforesaid, and subject to the conditions of the Charter of said Town and all revisions thereof and Amendments that may be made thereof, and also subject to the Ordinances of said City and the rules, regulations, and bylaws of the City Council, and Cemetery Committee or Committee now or hereafter which may be found relating to said cemetery and the burial of the dead therein, together with all and singular the Rights, members, Beneficiaries and Appertinances to said cemetery belonging or in any way incident or appertaining to the said all and singular incidents or appertinances to the said Cemetery premises before mentioned unto the said W. L. Trail, his heirs and assigns, against itself and its Successors in office to warrant and forever defend all and singular former, subject however to the limitations and conditions herebefore in force, and it does hereby itself and its Successors in office to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said W. L. Trail, his heirs and assigns, against itself and its Successors in office, lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof. Witness the seal of said City Council of Greenville this 16th day of January A. D. 1894. in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety four and in the one hundred eightieth year of the Sovereignty & Independence of the United States of America.
