E. corner of the Distillery building and running thence S. 210 feet to a rock; thence N. 210 feet to a rock; thence N. 210 feet to the Branch; thence S. down the Branch to the beginning corner containing one acre more or less and bounded on all sides by lands of the said Alice J. Connor do hereby certify that the said premises may be used by William C. Connor for the purpose of building a winter subject to the provisions of the said will and in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 10th day of July 1894 and I do hereby stipulate and agree that the laws of the United States for Taxes
