I now all meny by these presents, that
 The City Council of Greenville in the State aforesaid, for and in
 consideration of the sum of Twenty Dollars, to it in hands paid,
 at and before the sealing of these presents, by H. L. God, the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and
 released and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell and release unto
 the said H. L. God, for 1st to 100. of his improved Cemetery, having 140
 following dimensions, to wit: Sixty feet long by fifteen feet wide
 from the right side, burial and cemetery purposes, and to be used for
 cemetery or the right and purposes aforesaid and subject to the
 conditions of the right described of said grantee and all re-
 visions thereof and encroachments that may be made thereon, all
 also subject to the Ordinances of said City & its rules, regulations
 and by-laws of the City Chamberlain, Cemetery Trustee or Committee, now
 in force, or which may hereafter be passed relating to said
 cemetery and the burial of the dead therein. To whom will all
 and singular the rights Members! & creditmen and upholders
 to said premises sitting or in any wise incident or pertaining
 to have and to hold and all singular the said premises before men-
 tioned, unto the said H. L. God his heirs and assigns forever, sub-
 ject however to the limitations and conditions hereinbefore in-
 posed and it does hereby bind itself and its successors in office to
 warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises
 unto the said H. L. God, his heirs and assigns, against itself and
 its successors in office, lawfully claiming or to claim the same
 or any part thereof. Witness the seal of said City Council of Green-
 ville, this 31st day of October 1894, in the year of our Lord One
 thousand eight hundred and ninety four, and in the 117th year
 of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
