Whereas J. J. Ellison
and Tom M. Ellison as Trustees of J. J. Ellison
did exhibit their complaint in the Court
of Common Pleas for Greenville County on
the day of November A.D. 1894, against Abbie
Jane Ellison, Letitia Jay Ellison, P. C. Ellison
and William Ellison, praying among other
among other things that the exchange of lands
set out and described in said complaint
be authorized and directed, and whereas
said proceedings were had thereunder, that
on the 28th day of November A.D. 1894, an
order was made therein, directing among other
things, that the said P. C. Ellison execute and
deliver to said Tom M. Ellison as Trustee of J. J.
J. Ellison a Warranty deed to fifty two acres
of the land referred to the said Decreeal
Order as lot No. 1 on the plat made by the
Surveyor on the 31st day of October A.D. 1894,
upon the same terms, limitations and
conditions as those contained in the original
deed of William Ellison to Tom
M. Ellison as Trustee of J. J. Ellison and that
upon the delivery of said deed, the said William
M. Ellison as Trustee of J. J. Ellison as
executor, and deliver to the said P. C. Ellison in
exchange for said lot No. 1, a Warranty fee
simple deed to that portion of the Tract Order
containing sixty one acres of land, and
known as said lot No. 1 before referred to
as lot No. 4. And therefore in pursuance
of the terms of said order, and by the au-
thority and direction thereof, as well as
in consideration of the conveyance to me
the said Tom M. Ellison as Trustee of J. J. Elli-
son by said P. C. of said lot No. 1, here fully
described in the said deed to me of even
date herewith, I the said Letitia Jay Ellison
as Trustee of J. J. Ellison, have granted, have
granted and release, executed, conveyed,
