This instrument made
this 5th day of February 1895 between P. C. Horton
of Pamlico Lenoir County in said State and
John W. McCullough, Albia Greenville County
and said State, Parties of the first and
second part respectively, witnesses, that whereas
the said party of the first part is indebted
to said party of the second part in sundry sums of money
which he is at present unable to pay in full
and is desirous of providing for the payment
of the same, so far as in his power by an
assignment of all his property for that purpose.
And therefore the said party of the first part
in consideration of the sum and of the
sum of One Dollar to him paid by the party
of the second part upon the executing and doing
of these presents the receipt whereof is duly
acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold,
assigned, and transferred and set over and
by these presents does grant bargain, sell as
legally transfer and set over unto the said party
of the second part his line executing admiral
tenement, Land tenement, Appurtenances, goods
chattels, Stock, personal notes, debts claims
demands, property and effects of every descrip-
tion belonging to the said party of the first
part, whereas the said sum may be except
such as by law are and shall under execution
The said exempted property, being duly expressly
reserved, but to the extent only as the same
may be set apart to him as provided and
in the enjoyment thereof as provided by law
to him and to hold the same and any part
thereof unto the said party of the second part
his heirs and assigns forever in trust
whom to take possession of the same,
and to sell the same with all reasonable dis-
cretion, and to convert the same into money
and also to collect all debts claims
