 And whereas on the twenty sixth day of April 1895-
 the said O. J. Mills, J. G. Donaldson Jas. Binnie, J. P.
 Charles Wm. Wilkins Jr. E. S. Blackwood, Frank
 Hummwood and Henry Biggs were commissioned by
 me a Board of Corporation, authorizing and empowering
 them to open books of subscription to the Capital
 Stock of said proposed Corporation giving not less
 than one days previous notice by advertisement
 in a newspaper published in the County of Greenville
 giving notice of the time and place where said
 books of subscription would be opened,

And whereas, The said Board of Corporation
 on the Eighth day of July did file with the
 Secretary of State their return, in writing over
 their signature, certifying, among other things
 that more than fifty per cent of the Capital Stock
 has been subscribed, and twenty per cent has
 been paid in; and the Company has been organized
 according to law by the election of a Board of
 Directors, a President, Treasurer and Secretary.

Now Therefore, I D. H. Thompson, Secretary
 of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested
 by an Act of the General Assembly, entitled "An
 Act to Provide for the Formation of Certain Corpor-
 ations under General Law," approved the
 twenty third day of December 1886, and all
 acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that
 said Company has been fully organized,
 according to the Laws of South Carolina,
 under the name and for the purpose indicated
 in the within Declaration and that they are
 fully authorized under their Charter, and that
 a copy of this Certificate be filed, and recorded
 in the office of the Register of Meane Conveyance
 in each County, where such Corporation shall
 have a business office. Given under my
