To all to whom these presents shall come,
 I, D. P. Turner Master in and for the County of
 said South Carolina. Whereas C. G. P. Benty, on or about
 the 4th day of June 1895 exhibited his complaint
 in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County
 aforesaid, against John Jones Elizabeth C. Jones
 and Ann Maria P. Jones et al demanding judgment
 in relation to the real estate hereinafter men-
 tioned and described; and the cause being at
 issue came on to be heard on the 12th day of October
 1895; and such proceedings were had therein
 as resulted in a decree of the said Court,
 whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the
 said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described

 men by these presents that I, D. P. Turner Master
 in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid
 in consideration of the sum of Two thousand
 one hundred and eighty five dollars
 to me in hand paid by the said Lewis W.
 Parker the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 and by these presents do grant bargain sold and released
 unto & release unto the said Lewis Parker
