I AB Hughes of Greenville County in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of One thousand three hundred Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by William A Hudson Trustee of said County in the State aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained sold and released, and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William A Hudson Trustee, all that tract or plantation of land situate in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, seven miles East of the City of Greenville on a branch of Rocky Creek, Waters of Moore River, containing One hundred and Eleven acres, more or less, and having such marks bounds &c as follows; viz; Beginning on a stone 340, thence N 70 W 46.90 to a Pine 340, thence S 36 1/4 W 23.00 to a stone 340, thence S 57 1/4 E 37.80 to a Hickory 340, thence N 57 1/4 E 29.68 to the Beginning, Bounded by lands of B G G Hutzclaw, J G B Divers, H Ward, and others.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging; or in anywise incident or appertaining,

To have and to hold, all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the said William A Hudson Trustee his successors in office Heirs and assigns forever,

But only to, for and upon the following trusts that is to say, In trust for the sole, separate and exclusive use, benefit, and behoof of the children of from the said William A Hudson, share and share alike, the legal title to remain in the said William A Hudson, who is to take charge of said premises and cultivate the same and dispose of the crops and after paying expenses taxes and repairs, hold the remainder of the proceeds for the benefit of his children eastwardly trust, or heretofore paid premises and apply
