Whereas under the Act of the Legislature of South Carolina passed Dec. 24th 1890 the Trustees of the Tradeville Poor School and their Successor in office are authorized and enjoined to sell and convey in fee simple to any person who shall purchase all or any portion of the lands left by the last will and testament of Thomas Tradeville deceased for the support of a poor school in Laurens County if in their judgment it will be best for the interest of said school. And whereas it has been determined by said Trustees that it will be best in the interest of said school that the lands herinafter described be sold and the said lands being a portion of the lands left by the last will and testament of Thomas Tradeville deceased for the support of a poor school in Laurens County.

And therefore know all men by these presents, that M. C. Glouster, M. A. Crisp, J. M. Taylor, C. S. Fuller, & W. B. Workman, Trustees of the Tradeville Poor School of Laurens County in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and thirty seven ³⁷/₁₀₀ Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is truly acknowledged have granted, conveyed, sold and released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Robert Pickle, his heirs and assigns forever all that
