Whereas by an Act
of the General Assembly of the State
of South Carolina entitled An Act in
relation to Forfeited Lands, Deemments lands
and collection of Taxes, and Acts Amending
thereof it is provided that immediately upon
the expiration of the time allowed by law
for the payment of taxes in any year the
County Treasurers of each County shall issue
in the name of the State a warrant or
execution against each defaulting taxpayer in
his County, directed to the Sheriff or his
lawful deputy requiring and commanding
him to lay the same by distress and sale
of so much of the taxpayer's estate real or
personal or both as may be sufficient
