This Indenture made the twenty third of October in the year of our Lord One Thou- sand Eight Hundred and Sixty Six between Henry C. P. Mc Cormick of Charleston in the State aforesaid of the one part and Robert L. Duryea of the same place Trustee, Nominee and Appointed by the said H. C. P. Mc Cormick for the intent and purpose hereinafter men- tioned of the other part, witness that the said H. C. P. Mc Cormick for and in execution of a bargain contract which is intended to be strictly had and performed, between the said Henry C. P. Mc Cormick and Amalia M. Robertson of Charleston in the State aforesaid and for securing and providing for his said intended wife a competent provision and subsistence, and also for and in consid- eration of Five Dollars to him in hand paid by the said Robert L. Duryea at which time the making and doing of these presents the receipt thereof is fully acknowledged, and for other good cause and consideration both granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents doth Grant bargain sell and release unto the said Robert L. Duryea Trustee aforesaid. All that plantation or tract of land situated being and being on Georgetown Road in the Parish of Liberty County in the State aforesaid measuring and containing about upon her own acre (or) to be the same more or less. Beginning and bounding North on land of Thomas and George White and James River East on land of George White South on the said George River Road, and West on land of Thomas White and Thomas & George White. The said planta- tion or tract of land being a part or portion of the original tract delineated in a Plat drawn by R. H. Brown Surveyor dated March 1857 as belonging to the Estate of Dr Daniel Lopez called Elmo Green. And also all that lot of land
