

Survive the said Henry C. B. McCormick her said
intended husband, and there should be living
no issue of the said intended marriage then
in trust for the said Emily M. Robinson
for her life and I assign absolutely and forever ^{to her} and it is

so provided and agreed by and between the
said parties that the said Emily M. Robinson
her or her successors shall and may from time
to time reimburse herself and for herself
or her successors out of the said Trust Estate
all such necessary and reasonable charges
as she or they shall survive put into by reason
of this trust made payable to three persons, namely
being anything pursuant thereto, and that neither
she nor they shall be in any way accountable for
or liable to make good any more of the estate
than what shall really and bona fide
come into her hands or custody. And
that the receipt of the said Emily M. Robinson
or her during her life notwithstanding any
conversion and of the said Henry C. B. McCormick
after death shall be a sufficient receipt
and discharge to the Trustees or her successors for
any money or moneys which shall or may come
into her or their hands through or by reason of
this being paid thereto. And it is also pro-
vided if it shall so happen to be for the benefit
and advantage of the said Emily M. Robinson
that the said property should be sold, it shall
and may be lawfully done by the said Trustees
by and with the consent and approbation in
writing of the said Emily M. Robinson during
her life time and of the said Henry C. B. McCormick
after her death, at any time during the
continuance of this trust herein contained and
the money arising and to arise from such
sale or sales, shall be invested in such other
property, or in such other manner, as the said Em-
ily M. Robinson during her life, and the
said Henry C. B. McCormick after her death shall
in writing direct, and the property so bought
in the investment so made shall be taken with
