thence N 85 W 7.60 to a stone public line thence S 4 1/2 W 47.75 to a stone C.M.B.  
thence N 10 1/2 E 48.40 to the beginning containing twenty and 1/2 acres more or  
less. Also all that certain lot of land situate being in the aforesaid State  
of South Carolina on East side of Jordan road joining my lands. Beginning on a stone on the  
road running N 4 1/2 E 2.98 to the old Jordan road where the road once
