

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

Eugenia A. Stone in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Arthur D. Power, as Survivor of late James G. Power and Sarah (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Arthur D. Power, as such Survivor, all that piece parcel of land, situate, siting and being in the first ward of the City of Greenville in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid beginning at a stake on the east side of Butlerford Street corner of Gullis & Smiths lot and running thence with Smiths line one hundred and thirty four feet to a stake, thence fifty eight feet on a line parallel with Butlerford Street, thence one hundred and thirty four feet on a line parallel with said Smiths line, to a stake corner of Butlerford Street, thence fifty eight feet along said street to the beginning corner, the said lot being enclosed.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the said Arthur D. Power, as Survivor his Heirs and Assigns forever,

my trust, nevertheless, to be disposed of as the other assets of the said firm of G. Power & Son, in so far as they are affected by the terms of the will of the late Thomas Power,

And I do hereby bind myself and my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Arthur D. Power, as such Survivor his

Heirs and Assigns, against myself and my Heirs, and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
