(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. C. C. Turner* a certain tract or parcel of land, situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being in the vicinity of Greenville and a mile from said town, one the north side of the Eastgate Bridge, road 12 feet broad, 16 feet from the former and 15 feet yonder, if the road, and runs thence North 37° 44' West 12 chains 32 links to a small pine tree 37° 44' 21" chains 88 links bearing a small branch to a stake 34 miles 15 ft from center of the said road, thence, up the said road 15 feet from the center south 18° 45' chains 3 links to a bend in the said road, thence South 14° 45' 15 feet from center of the road 6 chains 64 links to the beginning of another 15 feet from center of the road opposite to the previous place containing ten acres more or less, this being the same tract of land conveyed to J. C. C. Turner by William Ward Wrenn on the 11th day of December 1889 and recorded in Book W. D. page 691

Heirs and Assigns, against *J. C. C. Turner* and *J. C. C. Turner* his Heirs, and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
