Starnes line S 61 1/2 W 10 1/4 to a stone 34 m, thence S 21 1/2 E 7 1/2 to a stone 34 m, on Dade mts line, thence N 42 1/2 W 8 to a stone 34 m at Hammonds corner, thence N 42 1/2 W 13 to a stone 34 m, thence N 43 E 7 3/8 with said Hammonds line to a stone 34 m on Turners road, thence with said road N 54 1/2 W 9 to the beginning, adjoining land of Messrs Mary D. Starnes, Wm. H. Humber, U. S. Hammond and others,

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the said U. S. Hammond his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said U. S. Hammond his
