 River, and is part of the tract of land known as the Mary Allen tract and
 granted to W.R. Southern by deed April the 4th 1877, and by W.D. Southern to Wm
 Tilly Sr, and is known as tract No 6 in the division of the real estate of
 Wm Tilly late of the County, deceased, and runs as follows: Beginning on
