(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
release unto the said William B. Tilley, a tract piece or parcel of land lying and
being situate in Greenville County, in the State aforesaid on Meadowfork Creek, waters
of Muskeet Creek, South Tyger River, and runs as follows, beginning on a Chestnut Oak 34
which is a corner of Am. Southern's land, and also a corner of Milton Grammell's land
and also of Hulda Gosnell's land, and runs thence with Hulda Gosnell's land in a
North East direction to a stone 34 on the south side of Meadowfork Creek, which is
also a corner of tract No 1, and also of No 2, tract, and thence with up the meander
of creek to a Willow 34 near the mouth of a small branch which is also the corner
of tract No 2 & 4, and runs on up said Meadowfork Creek to J.P. Pitman's line,
