(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Pettie Prince, all of that piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the county and State aforesaid on Pay Creek, waters of South Pyger river, Beginning on a stone running thence N 64 1/2 E 13.00 to a stone, thence N 10 W 37 1/2 E to a stone on said creek, thence down the meanders of the creek about 10.50 to a stone, thence S 18 3/4 W 16.16 to a stone, thence S 10 E 25.00 to the beginning containing fifty nine 7/10 acres (59 7/10) more or less, bounded by lands of David Cannon, S P Brown, and others, It is lot No 2,

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the said Pettie Prince his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself my Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Pettie Prince his

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof. WITNESS my Hand and Seal this 19th day of September A.
