(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.W.A. Hudson Jr., all that piece of land, situate in the State and County aforesaid, on branch waters of Richland Creek of Reedy River, 2 miles east of the Court House, on the north side of the road to Spartanburg, S.C., containing thirty two and one half acres, more or less, and hath such marks, bounds &c as follows viz: Beginning on a stone, on said road, Rist Street, thence along Spartanburg road to stone on Waddell St. 71-715-0 E 740 feet, thence along Waddell Street 71-344-0 W 148 feet to a stone, thence 71-244-0 W 620 feet to a stone, thence S 24 1/4 W along Waddell Street 772 feet to a stone, thence along Rist Street S 36 1/4 E 1749 feet - the beginning corner, bounded by lands of Hessler & Nelson, H. G. Elder - W.A. Hudson Trustee and others, known as the Homestead of Rev E. P. Priest - D.D. deceased, The consideration being a portion of the money left Mr. W. A. Hudson and W. J. Hudson and W. A. Austin Hudson prior to the death of their Grand Mother Ann A. Hudson, by her and for their benefit.
