Greenville County, South Carolina, and bounded by lands of J.S. Kellott,  
W.G. Bruce, the said W.W. Seaborn and others and having metes and  
bounds as follows: Beginning on a stone 34 rods said from Seaborn's line, with  
J.S. Kellott, thence N 64 W 2 1/4 rods to a stone 34, thence S 21 1/2 W 11 1/2 rods to a stone 34  
thence N 66 1/2 W 8 rods to a red oak 34, thence S 53 1/2 E 29 rods to a stone 34, thence S 53 1/2
