on old line, thence S 28 E 53 Pds 13, 28 pds, to stone 34 34 m, thence S 11 W 13, 40 pds to
stone 34 34 m, on Road, thence S 40 E 84 4, 60 pds to stone 34 34 m, on said Road,
thence S 62 E 86, 00 pds to bend, on stone 34 34 m, on said Road, thence S 83 E
