and before the sealing of these presents by Mildred H. Brown,  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and  
release unto the said Mildred H. Brown, all that certain piece parcel and lot of land  
containing forty six one hundredths (46<sup>1</sup>/<sub>100</sub>) of one acre, more or less, private lying and  
being in the south western part of the City of Greenville, and on the south side of  
Pendleton Street, and having the following metes and bounds, viz: Beginning at a stake 34 on  
said Pendleton Street, and running thence with said street according to the original  
bearing, 669 feet 100 feet to a stake 34, & means corner, thence 317 E with said means line  
to a stake 34, pm, on said line, thence N 69 E two feet to a stake 34, in substance N 69 E  
200 feet to the beginning. The same being the northern portion of a lot devised  
to me by my husband W. H. Thornburg, and which I conveyed to the said Thornburg  
by Samuel Bradley September 6th A.D. 1868, and to the said Bradley by W. A. Howard  
July 11th 1868, bounded on the north by Pendleton Street, on the west by St. H.  
Means lot, and on the south and east by Margaret Thornburg's lot.  
This sale being made by me by virtue of and in pursuance of a certain power vested in  
me by the provisions of the will of W. H. Thornburg, deceased, and being for the purpose stipulated  
therein, and being the lot mentioned by him in the fourth clause of his will, by which  
he gives me full power to sell the same, said clause reads as follows: "In  
case I do not sell the vacant lot adjoining my house place, during my life, I  
hereby authorize and empower my said wife Margaret Thornburg to sell and  
convey the same, and to use the proceeds in paying my debts, or her own  
debts, or in such other way as she may deem best for the interest of my  
estate, or for her own welfare."
