in the State aforesaid, I, George Sloane, of state aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Three hundred (\$300.00) Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Isaac Howard, of state aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Isaac Howard, all that lot of land situate in West Greenville State, and County aforesaid, and having the following angles and bounds, viz: Beginning at an iron stake corner of Frank Craig's lot, and running with said Frank Craig's line N 22° E 2 chains, to another iron stake, corner of Robert Scalls lot, thence with said Robert Scalls line S 67° E 1.25 rods to a stake, thence S 27° W 2 chains to a stake, thence N 47° W 1.25 rods to the beginning corner, containing one fourth ($\frac{1}{4}$) of an acre, more or less, and is the lot that was to me conveyed by James Moore, by deed bearing date September 24th 1892, and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County, in Vol. 2, Jr. at page 742.

This general warranty Deed is intended to warrant the title against every encumbrance, save and except a note & mortgage of \$425.00 payable to me at Greenville, on Aug. 22, 1895, with interest from date at 8%, payable annually, which mortgage embraces the property in this Deed described, and which was executed by me Aug. 22nd 1894.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said

Isaac Howard & to his Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Isaac Howard & to his

Heirs and Assigns, against all and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
