 release unto the said J P Gutinier all that tract of land situate in said County of State  
 on Piney Mountain containing 20.1 acres, more or less bounded by lands  
 of Croft, Smith, Griffin & others, and fully described as to metes and bounds by a  
 deed executed by D P Verner master for Greenville County to me dated April  
 2<sup>nd</sup> 1888, said Dr. J P Gutinier having paid the amount due by me on the pur-  
 chase, money & to secure himself its repayment, took my notes for \$5.00 on  
 a mortgage on the land herein described, of date February 20<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1887,

 defend all and singular the said premises unto the said

Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and every person whomsoever lawfully  
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
