release unto the said Pinkney & Plimley, a certain tract or parcel of land  
lying and being in Greenville Co., a part of State of Carolina on both  
sides of Bull Branch, branch waters of South Pacolet River; Beginning  
on a Maple 34 on waters of Bull Branch W.M. Gosnells corner  
running thence North East 13, 50 chains to a Chestnut oak 34 said  
W.M. Gosnells corner running thence a straight line about  
South East to a rock corner 34, W.M. Gosnells Jackson boundary,  
William M. Plimley corner running thence with the said  
Jackson boundary line to a black pine forest aft thence to a  
rock corner 34, Jacksons corner running thence North East  
to a chestnut oak 34 new corner, a conditional corner between  
William Plimley and Pinkney & Plimley running thence  
due west to a locust 34 another conditional corner, running  
thence North West with a ledge of rock to a hickory 34, new thence  
to a poplar 34, near the head of Bull Branch, running thence  
down the meanderings of said Branch to a poplar 34, running  
the same branch leaving the Branch to a small black oak 34 thence
