bounds: Beginning at a stake 340 m on the bank of the creek,
known as Gray Branch, thence down the meanderings of the
tract 3, thence with the line of such tract N 40 W Forty seven
Chains & Forty Links (47.140) to stake 34 m on line of Dr Austins
property, thence along Austins line S 57 1/2 W Fifteen Chains
(15.60) to stake 340 m at corner of lands of B P Holland, thence
along Hollands line S 34 1/2 E Fifty one Chains and Ten
