 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and  
 release unto the said Harriet Moultrie, all that certain piece or lot of  
 land in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State aforesaid  
 lying on the south side of Nichols Street, having the following  
 lines and bounds; Beginning at a stake on Nichols Street at  
 the corner of the lot of Sam'l Evans, thence with Nichols Street  
 $11\frac{3}{4}$  ft. or only three (3) ft. to stakes, thence for a line parallel to the  
 west line of Sam'l Evans lot, One hundred & Twenty five feet to slope  
 thence Forty three ft. to line of Sam'l Evans and thence with Evans  
 line One hundred & Twenty five (125) ft. to Beginning corner  
 Being a portion of the same lot formerly held to me by Martha  
 Sloan May 1st 1893 the deed for which is recorded in R.M.C.  
 office in Blk a ad p 244.
