(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Thos. B. Waters, all that piece of land and tract of land
containing eight and one half acres of land or more or less, situate
lying and being in Greenville County in the State aforesaid between
Miller's Creek off Greenville C. R. No. 11 Austin Township, and near by
Aurora Creek, adjoining lands of said J. W. A. Adams and said Thos.
B. Waters and having the following metes and boundaries, viz. - Begin
ing at a stone 3x4 in center of Mill road running across
from the Scuppernong road to the Mill road, that leads
to J. W. A. Adams' Roller Mill, and running thence S. 7 W. 1890 to a
stone 3x4 in center of Mill road, thence following said Mill road as a line N. 7 E. 16 C. to
an iron fence in center of said road, and the said J. W. A. Adams
his heirs and assigns reserve the right to keep the said Mill
Road between the two iron fences, twenty feet wide of need be
for traveling purposes, and running thence from said iron
