

The State of South Carolina

This indenture made in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Ninety six between E Charlotte James Administrator and W H James Administrator with the will annexed of the last will and testament of William Gibson late of Oneill Township in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, deceased of the first part, and A B Groce of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said parties of the first part, by virtue of the authority to them given in and by the said last will and testament, and in consideration of the sum of two thousand three hundred and twenty five dollars (\$2,325.00) to E Charlotte James and W H James paid by the said party of the second part have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all the estate right, title, interest, property possession claim and demand whatsoever, both in law and equity, which the said testator had at the time of his decease, and which the said parties of the first part have by virtue of the said last will and testament of William Gibson, deceased, of, in and to, all these two pieces, parcels and tracts of land, to wit:

Tract No 1: Beginning at a stake on the Rutherford road following farm road N 10 W 37.05 to a dog wood stake 34 nm (corner) thence along line of old ditch to a hazel nut bush (corner) thence S 6 E 45.60 to a stake on Rutherford road (corner) thence along line of said road 21.57 chains to starting point, adjoining lands of Mrs John Groce, J M Groce, D S Bray, and others, being tract No 1 in the division of the lands under the will of William Gibson deceased containing a little three and seven tenths (83.7) acres more or less, as shown by accompanying plat, surveyed by A G Taylor Surveyor September 10, 1896.

Also tract No 2: Beginning at a stake on Rutherford road running S 6 E 45.60 to N 10 W 37.05 with bush corner.

Tyger River, thence following said River to mouth of a Spring branch (corner) where it enters said River, thence following said branch to a Hickory and old oak stump S 2 E W 10.64 to cedar plantation Rutherford road, thence along line of said road 14.50 chains to starting point adjoining lands of G H Morris, Mrs Wm H Groce, John H Groce, D S Bray and others, being tract No 2 in the division of the lands under the will of William J Gibson, deceased containing eighty five and three tenths (85.3) acres, more or less, as shown by accompanying plat, surveyed by A G Taylor surveyor September 10, 1896.

Also Tract No 3: Beginning at a stone 34 nm on branch running thence N 24 E 27.42 to a stone N 31 48 10 chains to a stone corner thence N 45 W 31.25 to a stone 34 nm, corner thence along line of branch to the starting point, adjoining lands of William Dill, Carry Robert P. D. Gilbreath and others, being tract No 3 in the division of the lands under the will of William J Gibson, deceased containing Ninety (90) acres, more or less, as shown by accompanying plat, surveyed by A G Taylor surveyor September 10, 1896.

Together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the above described premises unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, to him and them or by their or his proper use and behoof forever, as fully and absolutely as the said parties of the first part can and ought to do, pursuant to their authority as aforesaid,
