and estate of in or to all that piece, parcel and tract
of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County
in the State of South Carolina, on the headwaters of Pinhook
Creek, waters of Reedy River, adjoining lands now or
formerly of Alexander Miller, Pleasant Moon,
J. H. Shuckton, and H. Jacobs, and containing
seventy acres, more or less.

Also of in or to all that piece, parcel or lot of land
situate, lying and being in the County and State
aforesaid near the corporate limits of the City of
Greenville, being part of the real estate formerly
belonging to E. J. Kemp, known and designated
in a plat made by J. R. Southern D. S., on the 13th
of October 1888, as Lot No 11, containing one and
one-half acres, and having such shape, size and
