Bridgeman & P.D. Gosnell and valued at One hundred & twenty Dollars the taxes, penalties and assessments thereon amounting to Fourteen \$10.00 Dollars; and Whereas, The above named G.S. Bridgeman & P.D. Gosnell having neglected to pay the County Treasurer of Greenville County the above taxes, assessments and penalties as prescribed by law, an execution was issued therefor, as directed by said Act, on the 9th day of April 1897, and lodged with the Sheriff of Greenville County; and Whereas, At a sale made as directed by said Act, by the said Sheriff after levy under said execution and due notice to Eva B. Levine because the purchaser and having paid to the said Sheriff the said amount, Now, therefore, I, P.D. Gilbreath, the said Sheriff of Greenville County in consideration of the premises and in further consideration of the sum of Sixty Five Dollars given and received from the said Eva B. Levine, do hereby release and forgive all the said Eva B. Levine from and against all claims, demands, debts, suits, judgments, expenses, costs, and expenses of any kind whatsoever, which she may have or may hereafter have against me, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors, assigns, or any of them.
