

thence South 105 ft to beginning corner, containing one fourth acre, more or less, and bounded on all sides by lands of T. W. Williams, and I do hereby consent that the said premises may be used by George W. James for the purpose of distilling spirits for a period of two years from Sept. 10th 1897. Subject to the provisions of law, and I do hereby stipulate and agree that the laws of the United States for penalties and taxes shall have priority of my right title and interest in said tract of land or any claim in my behalf, and that in case of forfeiture of said premises or any part thereof the title to the same shall vest in the United States discharged from all my title interest or any claim in my behalf.
