McElrath and C B McElrath, of Greenville County in the State of South Carolina, have granted, bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said J G McElrath and C B McElrath, all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville on the east side of the road leading from Greenville to Spartanburg, about four miles from Greenville City, bounded according to a plat of J G Hoyt, 1853, except so much (eleven acres and three-quarters, more or less) deeded to E W Hudson, said tract now containing thirty three and one quarter acres, more or less, and being the same tract conveyed to the said William Goundes by E T Bush by deed dated the 10th of October 1854, recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, in Book 74, p. 408.
