Giving and granting unto my said attorney by these presents full and whole power, strength & authority, in and about the premises to have use, and take all lawful ways and means in my name for the recovery thereof; and upon the receipt of any such debts, dues, or sums of money aforesaid, acquittances or other sufficient discharges for me and in my name to make seal, and deliver; and generally all and every other act and acts, thing and things device and devices in law whatsoever, needful and necessary to be done in and about the premises, for me and in my name to do, execute and perform, as fully, largely and amply to all intents and purposes, as I might or could do if I were personally present, or if the matter required more special authority than is herein given, and attorneys one or more under me for the purpose aforesaid, to make and constitute and again at pleasure to revoke; ratifying, allowing and holding for firm and effectual, all and whatsoever my said attorney shall lawfully do in and about the premises by virtue thereof.
