sold and released, and by these Presents
do grant, bargain sell and release unto
the said J. W. Nesbit all that certain piece
parcel or tract of land being and lying
situated in State and County aforesaid
in mountain creek containing eight acres more
or less bounded by lands of J. R. Hill,
John Kline, W. H. Moore and others.
