Whereas Thomas A Walker late of the County of  
Greenville and State aforesaid, departed this life  
leaving his will duly executed, whereby he gave  
the tract of land hereinafter described to his widow  
Elizabeth Walker during her life time, and after  
her death to the children of them the said Thomas A  
& Elizabeth Walker, and whereas Annie B Walker  
the wife of T. C. Walker, one of said children has  
purchased all or nearly all the interests of all  
the other children of said Thomas A & Elizabeth Walker  
now therefore know all men by these Presents  
that I the said Elizabeth Walker of the County  
of Greenville and State of South Carolina, in  
consideration of the sum of Five Dollars to  
me paid by Annie B. Walker, and also in  
consideration of the premises aforesaid have  
granted bargained sold and released and by  
these presents do grant bargain sell and release  
unto the said Annie B. Walker all my  
right title claim and interest of every kind  
and nature whatsoever (Reserving to myself  
the right to use occupy and enjoy during  
my lifetime) all that piece parcel and tract  
of land situate lying and being in the County  
of Greenville, in the State aforesaid about nine  
miles from Greenville Court House on the  
Spartanburg road, joining lands of W. C. Daugh  
Margaret Barber, W. C. Brubaker, John A. J. Jr  
Kate Sheppard, Lemuel Warrham, Marshall  
Joseph Brown, Frank Newell and others  
by the house place of the said Annie B. Walker

acres, more or less, together with all and singular  
the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances  
to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident  
or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular  
the said Premises before mentioned unto the said  
Annie B Walker (after my decease) her heirs and assigns  
forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs  
executors and administrators to warrant and  
forever defend all and singular the said premises  
unto the said Annie B Walker her heirs and assigns  
against me and my heirs and all other persons  
or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or  
to claim the same or any part thereof.
