 J. M. Moon the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have granted bargained sold and released, and
 by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
 unto the said J. M. Moon, a certain tract or parcel
 of land in the State and County above named
 on the waters of North Tyger bounded by lands
 of A. Ballenger, M. Ballou and O. Barton and others,
 as follows: - Beginning on a Chestnut oak 37,
 between G. W. Center and A. Ballenger and Ballou,
 and O. Barton & others, a South West direction
 with Ballou and Ballenger line to a Post Oak
 34, thence nearly West to Mrs. Ballenger's line to
 the road, leading from Glassy Mountain Me-
 ting House to G. C. Mc (to a rock 34) thence along
 said road a North direction to a stone 37, betw-
 een N. Center & Barton, thence a straight line
 to the beginning 34, containing One hundred
 and twenty acres, more or less.
